

ADDITION OF TABLE 1 TO PROTOCOL I ON EXCHANGE OF CONCESSIONS ON
AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

THE JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Interim Free Trade Agreement establishing a Free Trade Area between the Republic of Turkey and the Palestine Liberation Organization for the benefit of the Palestinian Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Both Sides", "the Turkish Side" or "the Palestinian Side" where appropriate), signed on 20 July 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"),

Having regard to Article 7 of this Agreement concerning the exchange of concessions in trade of basic agricultural and processed agricultural products and fisheries between the Parties;

Having regard to Article 50 of this Agreement, empowering the Joint Committee to decide to amend the Protocols and Annexes to this Agreement;

Having considered the request of the Palestinian Side for duty free treatment within a tariff quota of 1.000 tonnes for the dates of Palestinian origin on importation into Turkey,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Table 1, concerning the preferential tariff rates applicable to agricultural products originating in Palestinian National Authority, shall be added to Protocol I of this Agreement.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force according to the provisions of Article 49 of this Agreement with regard to Amendments.
