### Türkiye's Exports Up 4.3% to \$178.1B in January-August

#### Foreign trade deficit at \$60B in same period



Türkiye's exports totaled \$178.1 billion during the first eight months of the year, up 4.3% on a yearly basis, the Turkish Trade Ministry announced.

In August alone, the country's exports contracted by 0.9% to \$21.8 billion, while the foreign trade deficit narrowed by 16.7% to \$4.16 billion in August, while the export-import coverage ratio was at 83.9%, up from 81.5%.

### Türkiye's Industrial Production Hits 16-Month High in June

#### Industrial production index up 8.3% year-on-year in June, while high technology index surges 88.2%



Türkiye's industrial production expanded 8.3% year-on-year in June, hitting the highest level in 16 months, the Turkish Statistical Institute (TurkStat) said. Of the 12 sub-sectors measured, 10 posted annual rises, while two declined. The high technology index soared 88.2%, capital goods climbed 20%, and manufacturing rose 9.5% compared to June last year. On a monthly basis, the overall industrial production expanded 0.7% in June.

Of the 12 sub-sectors measured, six posted monthly rises, while the other six declined. Among monthly figures, high technology production surged 38.1%, capital goods rose 4.8%, and the electricity, gas, steam index gained 1.9%.

Evaluating the data, Türkiye's Trade Minister Prof Dr Ömer Bolat stressed that the industrial production index reached its highest level in the last 16 months on an annual basis in June. Bolat stated that in the second quarter of this year, the index rose to 5.5%, demonstrating the strengthening of growth performance. "Accordingly, the Turkish economy, which grew by 2% in the first quarter of this year, is expected to achieve even stronger growth in the second quarter," he said in a written statement. Turkish economy expected to achieve stronger growth results in Q2 compared to previous quarter, Trade Minister says.

## Türkiye's GDP to Exceed \$1.4T at End-2025, Trade Minister Says

### Türkiye among fastest-growing economies in world over last decade, says Prof Dr Ömer Bolat



Türkiye's national income increased from \$238 billion in 2002 to \$1.32 trillion last year, the Turkish Trade Minister said, adding: "We will hopefully exceed \$1.4 trillion by the end of this year." Turkish economy has grown at an average annual rate of 5.3% over the past 22 years, Türkiye has been among the fastest-growing economies in the world over the past 10 years," he said. Bolat noted that merchandise exports, which were \$36 billion in 2002, had risen to \$262 billion last year.

"Our growth rate continued in the first seven months of this year, closing at \$156.4 billion with a 5.2% increase.", he added. Thus, we added a total of \$7.6 billion in value to the Turkish economy in just seven months." Bolat stressed that Türkiye's global export share has increased to 1.07%, with exports of \$37.5 billion in automotive, \$32 billion in textiles and clothing, \$35 billion in chemicals and energy, and \$32.5 billion in agricultural products. "In July, we surpassed the \$25 billion mark for the first time. On March 28, we achieved a record export figure exceeding \$2 billion per day," he said, adding: "As of July, our goods exports over the past 12 months reached \$269.4 billion, the highest level in the history of the republic." This strong performance in exports has become clear evidence that Türkiye is on an upward trajectory in industry, agriculture, and services, with quality, competitiveness, and advancing technology, he underlined.

## WTO Raises Global Trade Growth Forecast This Year, Decreases for 2026

### US importing goods in advance to avoid impact of tariffs causes upward trend in global trade forecast, but 2026 prediction falls



The World Trade Organization (WTO) raised its forecast for global trade growth this year to 0.9%, warning that the US' high tariffs will put pressure on trade in 2026. The previous WTO report, published tariff announcements on April 2, predicted that tariffs would cause global trade to contract by 0.2% this year. This forecast was significantly lower than the WTO's estimate of 2.7% growth before tariffs were imposed.

In its update, the WTO revised its forecast for global trade contraction this year from 0.2% to 0.9% growth. But this increase was largely due to the US importing goods in advance to avoid the impact of tariffs. In the first half of this year, the volume of imports in the US increased by 11% year-on-year. A similar trend was observed in other countries' imports due to concerns over retaliation. However, WTO economists warned that tariffs that came into effect would slow trade in the second half of this year and the next year. Economists also lowered their growth forecast for 2026 from 2.5% to 1.8%.

## G20 Countries' Goods Trade Posts Modest Growth in 2nd Quarter

**Total exports up 2.6%, while imports remain broadly unchanged in Q2 quarter-on-quarter, due to sharp contraction in imports into US following earlier rise in imports in Q1**



The Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) reported that G20 international goods trade saw a slight increase in the second quarter of 2025 due to the sharp contraction in imports into the US, following the earlier rise in imports in the first quarter. The total exports rose 2.6% in the second quarter compared to the previous quarter, while imports were broadly unchanged.

"This was largely due to the sharp contraction in imports into the United States following the earlier surge in imports in Q1 2025," an OECD statement said. "Trade outcomes in Q2 2025 were influenced by the depreciation of the US dollar against most currencies and rising trade uncertainty, following new tariff announcements," it said.

In the US, exports rose 2.7% in the second quarter, supported by higher sales of finished metal shapes and non-monetary gold. On the other hand, imports to the US fell 18.4%, reflecting a decline in purchases of industrial supplies. Lower oil prices weighed on exports from Canada, which contracted by 9.7%, while imports were broadly unchanged.

On the other hand, the goods trade in the majority of Asia and Europe grew steadily. With the help of semiconductors and other high-tech goods, China's imports and exports climbed 4.7% and 2.5%, respectively. Similarly, high-bandwidth memory chips and semiconductors drove a 7.1% increase in South Korea's exports. In Europe, exports increased by 7.4% in Germany, 6.0% in France, and 5.9% in Italy, while overall imports increased by 6.3% and exports by 4.7% in the EU, respectively. Due to higher purchases of cars and medications, the UK's imports increased 8.5% while its exports increased 1.3%.

However, Brazil's and Argentina's exports fell (by 3.6% both), while imports rose 9.3%. Australia's exports rose 1.8%, mostly in the form of scrap metal and metallic ores. Meanwhile, the services trade across the G20 saw a strong growth in the second quarter, with exports and imports rising by 4.7% and 2.9%, respectively.

## Erdoğan Presses for Stronger SCO Partnership, Lauds Tradition of Collective Action

**Speaking at the SCO summit in China, Turkish President Erdoğan welcomes recent steps toward lasting peace and stability in the South Caucasus and Central Asia.**



Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan has said he hopes to strengthen cooperation with the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO), calling it a platform “representing the tradition of finding joint solutions to problems.” Speaking at the 25th SCO Heads of State Council Summit in China's Tianjin, Erdoğan described the organisation as “vital” for boosting energy security and fostering strategic infrastructure partnerships. He also welcomed recent steps toward lasting peace and stability in the South Caucasus and Central Asia. The two-day SCO meeting, marked the fifth annual summit hosted by China since the forum was established in 2001.

Erdoğan concluded by outlining Türkiye's broader foreign policy vision, emphasising the importance of dialogue, diplomacy, and cooperation based on respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of all countries. He highlighted the importance of developments in energy and connectivity for global stability, economic development, and sustainable growth.

### **Turkish president discusses trade, energy, regional peace in talks with leaders of China, Russia, Pakistan, Iran, Azerbaijan, Armenia**

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan held bilateral meetings with several world leaders in China's Tianjin city on the sidelines of the 25th Shanghai Cooperation Organization Council of Heads of State Summit. In talks with Chinese President Xi Jinping, Erdoğan underlined the need to support bilateral trade with investments to ensure it is balanced and sustainable.

He stressed that sectors such as digital technologies, energy, health, and tourism hold significant potential, and noted that enhancing coordination for Chinese firms to invest in Türkiye would be mutually beneficial. Erdoğan emphasized the importance of taking joint steps to align the Middle Corridor with the Belt and Road Initiative. During the meeting, where both sides agreed on the regular functioning of existing consultation and cooperation mechanisms, Erdoğan highlighted the strategic dimension of bilateral relations.



On the sidelines of the summit, Erdoğan also met with Russian President Vladimir Putin. The meeting addressed bilateral relations between Türkiye and Russia, as well as regional and global issues. Erdoğan noted that relations between Türkiye and Russia continue to advance on the basis of mutual respect and common interests, stressing that the spirit of cooperation rooted in the past persists in areas such as trade, tourism, investments, and energy.

President Erdoğan received Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif. The meeting addressed bilateral relations between Türkiye and Pakistan, as well as regional and global issues. In his remarks during the meeting, Erdoğan stated that Türkiye and Pakistan are striving to enhance cooperation in many areas, particularly trade, energy, defense industry, and security.

Erdoğan also met with Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian at the Meijiang Convention Center. Their talks focused on Türkiye-Iran bilateral relations, as well as regional and global developments. During the meeting, Erdoğan stated that cooperation between Türkiye and Iran, particularly in the field of energy, serves the common interests of both countries. He added that they see benefit in Iran's pursuit of nuclear negotiations and stressed that Türkiye will continue to support Iran in this regard.

The Turkish president also met with Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev to discuss bilateral ties as well as regional and global issues. He stressed the importance of Türkiye and Azerbaijan coordinating future regional development initiatives and noted that the two countries will continue advancing cooperation in areas such as energy and transport.

In a separate meeting, President Erdoğan also received Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan, and noted that steps to enhance cooperation between Türkiye and Armenia were being considered.

### **Damascus International Fair to Create Opportunities for Türkiye-Syria Trade Cooperation**

**Trade event reopens with Turkish trade delegation aiming to establish joint customs committee, working groups with 'win-win' approach, says Turkish Trade Minister**



The 62nd Damascus International Fair will open new doors to Türkiye-Syria trade cooperation, as a key platform will review mutually beneficial trade areas while representing an opportunity to take a significant step in customs sector between the two countries. Turkish Trade Minister Prof Dr Ömer Bolat and a delegation of Turkish businesspeople attended the fair. The event has contributed to the efforts for the Turkish business community to take significant steps into the Syrian market, while deepening relations between the two countries.

Bolat said that the event will help establish stability and peace, while contributing to the constructive dialogue between Türkiye and Syria. The minister said that Türkiye's participation to the event is a testament to the country's support for Syria's reconstruction and its efforts to strengthen trade and cultural ties between the two countries. "This fair, held after a long hiatus, is key in reviewing mutual cooperation opportunities," he said.

Turkish representatives from food, iron and steel, paper products, furniture, and automotive sectors has participated in the fair. Bolat highlighted that the event will contribute to the trade relations between the two countries with the visit of the delegation from the Turkish Exporters' Assembly (TIM) to make high-level contacts with the newly established government in Syria. "We're taking steps to pave the way for mutual trade liberalization in the coming period with a 'win-win' approach," he said.

Bolat mentioned that he had visited Damascus in April after Syrian Economy Minister Nidal Al Sha'ar visited Türkiye with a delegation at the beginning of August to sign many agreements between the two countries. Bolat said that comprehensive talks with Al Sha'ar will be held at the event to demonstrate once again Türkiye's intent in cooperation. "We declared our commitment to taking our customs cooperation to a higher level, and with this declaration, we aim to form the legal basis for international cooperation in customs and consequently establish a joint customs committee and working groups in a mutual administrative assistance agreement," he said.

Bolat said that Türkiye's trade with Syria broke a record at over \$2.6 billion last year, while the bilateral trade volume exceeded \$1.9 billion in the first seven months of 2025. He noted that the majority of last year's \$2.18 billion worth of Turkish exports to Syria were processed agricultural products like sunflower oil, flour, and rice, as well as water, cakes, and biscuits. Bolat highlighted that Turkish exports to Syria soared 53% in January-July this year to \$1.8 billion. He mentioned that the Syrian market demands durable consumer goods and furniture products, which Turkish exporters can provide. "Syria may also obtain health equipment and medicine from Türkiye after the supply of these were disrupted due to the civil war," he said. "We observed that Türkiye's trade with Syria increased both in quantity and variety since the end of the civil war -- the lifting of export restrictions on Syria was an important step for our countries to meet the growing demand."

"We will continue to mobilize our ministry within a framework of humanitarian responsibility and without opportunism to boost Türkiye's exports to Syria and enable our countries to take a stronger position in the country's reconstruction," he added. Bolat said that Türkiye aims to continue mutual visits and keep trade relations alive as a short-term priority, while attaching significance to the Joint Economic and Trade Commission signed with Syria. "In the long term, we plan to establish a comprehensive economic partnership deal to cover trade in goods, services, public procurement, and investments, as we pave the way to harmonize the economies of the two countries by providing training and seminars to develop Syria's capacity," he said.

### **Türkiye, Syria sign deal to launch business council, boost economic ties**

The agreement, backed by nine additional Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs), sets the stage for private sector collaboration in Syria's reconstruction through Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) and Public-

Private Partnership (PPP) models. Türkiye and Syria have signed a MoU to establish a joint Business Council aimed at re-establishing institutional cooperation between the two countries, Republic of Türkiye Ministry of Trade announced. The agreement was formalised during a roundtable meeting chaired by Syrian Economy and Industry Minister Nidal Al-Shaar and Türkiye's Deputy Trade Minister Özgür Volkan Ağar. The session also included members of Türkiye's Foreign Economic Relations Board (DEİK) and a Syrian delegation, along with business leaders from both countries.

The discussions focused on cooperation opportunities within Syria's post-war reconstruction process, particularly in the areas of infrastructure and public services through BOT and PPP models. "To re-establish institutional cooperation between the two countries, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed to establish the Türkiye-Syria Business Council," the Trade Ministry said in a statement. "With nine additional MoUs signed between civil society organisations from both sides, a strong and sustainable foundation for cooperation has been created."

Additionally, Türkiye and Syria signed the "Protocol on the Establishment of the Türkiye-Syria Joint Economic and Trade Committee (JETCO)".

### **Türkiye taking modernization steps to ease border crossing with Syria, accelerate trade, cement safety**

Aleppo will soon become a strong logistics hub and Syria's transport corridors will become active again, the Turkish trade minister said. "Our trucks will no longer carry out transshipment or trailer changes at the Syrian border," Prof Dr Ömer Bolat said in a round-table meeting with Syrian Economy and Industry Minister Nidal Al-Sha'ar.

Bolat said Türkiye is taking modernization steps to ease border crossing with Syria to accelerate bilateral trade and cement safety. He said Syria has the power to rebuild thanks to the hard work and productivity of its people, and the effect of that spirit will soon be felt more strongly from industry to agriculture, manufacturing and the service sector. Emphasizing that Türkiye is ready to make its strongest contribution to the process of recovery, reconstruction and rebuilding, Bolat said Ankara believes Turkish companies will take the lead in Syria with their expertise and experience in areas of manufacturing to infrastructure, banking and construction.

### **Free 24-hour transit trade via 2 customs gates**

24-hour transit trade has been free at two customs gates, Türkiye's Cilvegozu and Oncupinar, and Syria's Babel Air and Babusselam,' Turkish Trade Minister Prof Dr. Ömer Bolat said. Bolat said Syria has made great strides in terms of political stability and social peace since the "December 8 Revolution" and that Türkiye will continue to stand by Syria in the new era.

## Türkiye, Senegal Sign 4 Agreements in Fields of Defense, Media, Education

**Agreements include military financial cooperation, joint media production, and higher education collaboration for 2025–2028**



Türkiye and Senegal signed four agreements to enhance cooperation in the fields of defense, media, and education. Following one-on-one talks and inter-delegation meetings between Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan and Senegalese Prime Minister Ousmane Sonko at the Presidential Complex in Ankara, the two countries held a signing ceremony for the agreements.

Turkish National Defense Minister Yasar Guler and Senegalese Minister of the Armed Forces General Birame Diop signed the Military Financial Cooperation Agreement, along with the First Amendment Protocol to the Cash Assistance Implementation, on Jan. 28, 2020. The Agreement on Co-Production and Cooperation in the Fields of Film, Audiovisual and Multimedia was signed by Turkish Trade Minister Prof Dr Ömer Bolat and Senegalese Minister of African Integration and Foreign Affairs Yassine Fall.

Additionally, the memorandum of understanding between Türkiye’s Council of Higher Education (YÖK) and Senegal’s Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research on Cooperation in the field of Higher Education for the years 2025-2028 was signed by YOK President Erol Ozvar and Fall.

## Turkish Businesspeople Invest \$2.3B, Employ 35K Workers in Africa

**Turkish contractors finalized over 2K projects worth \$97.5B in total, says Turkish Trade Minister Prof Dr Ömer Bolat at Türkiye–Africa business event, World Cooperation Industries Forum, in Istanbul**



Turkish businesspeople have invested \$2.3 billion and employed 35,000 people in Africa, while the country’s construction business has been actively working on the continent with over 2,300 projects under its belt, the Turkish trade minister said. Speaking at the Türkiye-Africa business event, the World Cooperation Industries (WCI) Forum, in Istanbul, Prof Dr Ömer Bolat said Turkish construction projects on the continent totaled \$97.5 billion, accounting for 18% of the construction businesses' overseas projects.

“Tens of thousands of Africans have been employed with our investments in the continent,” he said. “Africa has been very close to us, as it takes only a 45-minute flight from Türkiye’s southern coast cities to reach the continent. Türkiye–Africa relations accelerated rapidly in politics, diplomacy, trade, tourism, and investments after President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan took office at the end of 2002,” he noted, adding that the year 2005 was dubbed the “Year of Africa” in Türkiye after the Turkish government announced its strategy for the region in 2003.

“Turkish Airlines plays a key role in bridging 54 African countries to the world, while the number of our embassies on the continent rose from 12 in 2003 to 44—we hope to reach 50 embassies soon,” he said. “The total trade between Türkiye and the African continent was \$5.4 billion in 2003, but this figure rose sevenfold to \$36.5 billion by 2024, while our exports totaled \$21.8 billion and we imported around \$15 billion,” he added.

The minister said work is underway to strengthen relations with some 26 Muslim-majority countries in Africa, while the key sectors Türkiye is interested in in Africa are machinery, electrical, chemicals, automotive, agricultural products, and ferrous and steel products. Bolat said the Turkish Ministry of Trade participated in 65 events held on the African continent in 2023–24, while Türkiye organized 33 business events in the region this year. Meetings were conducted with more than 50 African state officials, while some 79 procurement delegation programs were organized in the last two years, he added. The minister noted that African imports to Türkiye included raw materials, energy products, petroleum, natural gas, oil, mineral products, cocoa, coffee, sesame seeds, and other agricultural products. “We have also seen a major breakthrough in the service sector,” he said. “I can say with confidence that Türkiye’s total exports will reach nearly \$400 billion by the end of the year, \$274 billion of which will be goods and \$123 billion of which will be in services.”

“Türkiye’s service exports to Africa reached \$6 billion in 2023, while Africa exported \$5.1 billion worth of services to Türkiye,” he noted. “Meanwhile, tourism grows every year—some 1.5 million African tourists visited Türkiye in 2024, while some 600,000 have visited so far this year.”

### **Türkiye Attracts \$6.3B in Foreign Direct Investments in H1**

**Since 2022, the volume of foreign direct investments (FDI) has exceeded \$281B in Türkiye, says International Investors Association.**



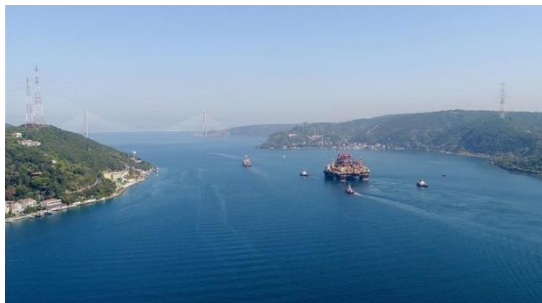
Türkiye attracted foreign direct investments (FDI) worth \$6.3 billion during the first half of the year, the International Investors Association announced. The amount of FDI in the country rose by 27% year-on-year in the January to June period, the association said in a press release. In June alone, the volume of the FDI reached \$1.6 billion, while exceeding \$281 billion since 2022, it noted. Of the total FDI inflows of \$6.3 billion, \$3.9 billion was recorded in the form of investment capital.

The figures showed that \$2.2 billion of the FDI came through debt instruments, while \$0.9 billion came through real estate sales to foreigners. Interest rate cuts and easing inflation are among the factors driving investments.

### Turkish Straits Welcome Nearly 41K Vessels in H1

**14,027 general cargo vessels and 7,278 bulk carriers used Turkish Straits, while number of container ships reached 5,294, carrying total of 754.6M gross tons of cargo, says Transport Minister Abdulkadir Uraloglu**



The Turkish Straits welcomed some 40,988 vessels in the first six months of the year, Turkish Transport Minister Abdulkadir Uraloglu told the press. “In January-June, some 19,381 ships passed through the İstanbul Strait, while some 21,607 ships transited via the Canakkale Strait,” he added.

The Turkish Straits- the İstanbul and Canakkale Straits- are two critical waterways in Türkiye, known globally as the heart of maritime traffic, as they connect Asia and Europe, forming a vital global trade route. The minister said some 14,027 general cargo vessels and 7,278 bulk carriers used the straits, while the number of container ships reached 5,294, carrying a total of 754.6 million gross tons of cargo.

The number of ships calling at Turkish ports reached 29,444, with 9,880 Turkish and 19,564 foreign-flagged vessels carrying a total gross cargo of 463.8 million tons, according to the Minister. The northwestern province of Kocaeli had the most ships call at its port in the first six months of the year, totaling 4,564, with 1,295 Turkish and 3,269 foreign-flagged. The number of ships hailing at Kocaeli was followed by the southwestern port of Aliaga in the Aegean Sea with 2,240 foreign and 835 domestic ships, Iskenderun port in the East Mediterranean with 1,788 foreign ships, and the port of Mersin in southern Türkiye with 1,631 foreign-flagged vessels. Meanwhile, Ambarli port in the northwest received 800 Turkish-flagged ships, and the port of Marmara saw 734 domestic vessels.

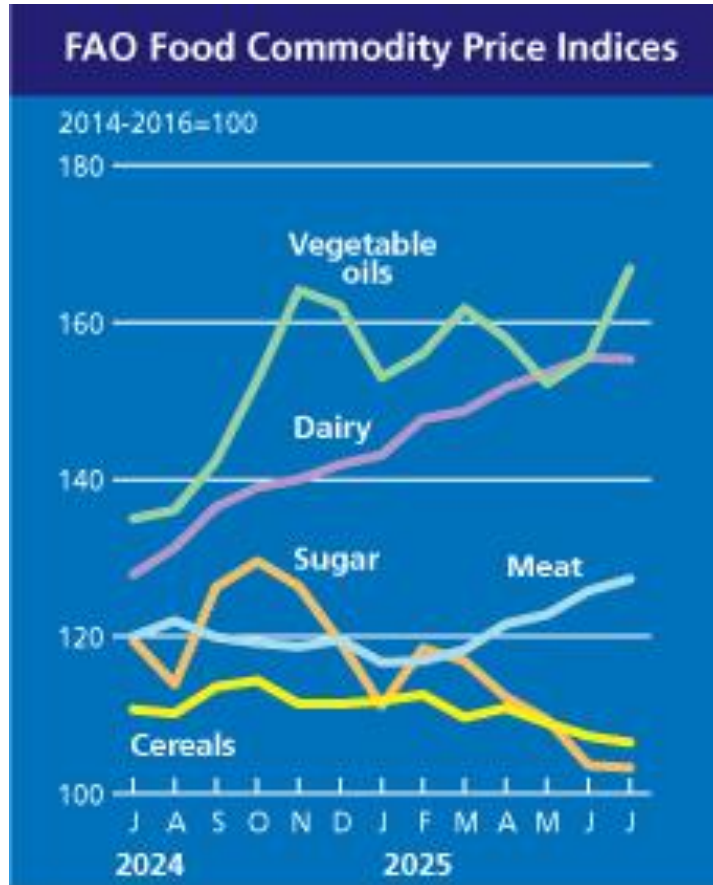

### FAO Food Price Index Rises in July on Higher Meat and Vegetable Oil Prices

The FAO Food Price Index (FFPI) averaged 130.1 points in July 2025, marking an increase of 2.1 points (1.6 percent) from June. While the price indices for cereals, dairy and sugar declined, they were outweighed by increases in the indices for meat and vegetable oils. Overall, the FFPI was 9.2 points (7.6 percent) higher than in July 2024, yet remained 30.1 points (18.8 percent) below its peak reached in March 2022.





The **FAO Cereal Price Index** averaged 106.5 points in July, down 0.8 points (0.8 percent) from June and 4.2 points (3.8 percent) from July 2024. Global export prices of barley and maize rose, while those of sorghum and wheat declined. Abundant seasonal supplies from ongoing winter wheat harvests in the northern hemisphere placed downward pressure on prices; however, below average conditions for spring wheat in parts of northern America, coupled with reluctant farmer selling in Europe and the Black Sea region, provided some support. Slow farmer selling interest also weighed on international maize prices, as did dry conditions in Eastern Europe and parts of Ukraine and reduced export availabilities from Argentina and Brazil, due to export taxes and stronger domestic demand, respectively. Meanwhile, the FAO All Rice Price Index fell by 1.8 percent in July 2025, as ample exportable supplies and lacklustre import demand continued to weigh on prices.

The **FAO Vegetable Oil Price Index** averaged 166.8 points in July, up 11.1 points (7.1 percent) month-on-month and reaching a three-year high. The increase was driven by higher quotations for palm, soy and sunflower oils, more than offsetting the decline in rapeseed oil prices. International palm oil prices rose for the second consecutive month in July, primarily underpinned by continued robust global import demand fuelled by improved price competitiveness compared to other vegetable oils. Meanwhile, soy oil quotations were bolstered by prospects of firm feedstock demand from the biofuel sector in the Americas, while sunflower oil prices rose due to seasonally tightening supplies in the Black Sea region. By contrast, global rapeseed oil prices declined in July, mainly pressured by the arrival of new crop supplies in Europe.

The **FAO Meat Price Index** averaged 127.3 points in July, up 1.5 points (1.2 percent) from June and 7.3 points (6.0 percent) from July 2024, and reaching a new all-time high. The increase was primarily driven by higher bovine and ovine meat prices, along a slight increase in poultry meat quotations, while pig meat prices declined. Global bovine meat prices reached a new record high, supported by higher

quotations in Australia, underpinned by strong import demand, particularly from China and the United States of America, which outpaced available export supplies. Robust global demand also contributed to firmer prices in Brazil. Ovine meat prices increased markedly for the fourth consecutive month, reflecting limited export supplies from Oceania amid sustained global demand. Poultry meat prices edged up slightly, bolstered by higher Brazilian export prices following the easing of restrictions and the gradual resumption of imports by several key trading partners after Brazil regained its high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI)-free status in mid-June. By contrast, pig meat prices declined, mainly due to lower quotations in the European Union, where ample domestic supplies coincided with subdued global purchasing interest.

The **FAO Dairy Price Index** averaged 155.3 points in July 2025, down 0.2 points (0.1 percent) from June but 21.5 percent higher than its value in July 2024. The marginal decline – the first since April 2024 – was driven by lower international prices for butter and milk powders, which were largely offset by continued increases in cheese quotations. The butter price index fell by 1.1 percent, marking its first decline in six months, driven primarily by weaker quotations from Oceania, where increased production and rising inventories weighed on prices. However, firm butter prices in the European Union, underpinned by tight cream availability and strong demand, contained the overall drop. The indices for whole and skim milk powders continued to decrease, reflecting ample export supplies from Oceania and subdued import demand, particularly from China and other key Asian markets. By contrast, international cheese prices rose, supported by sustained demand from Asian and Near East markets and reduced export availability in the European Union, although the increases were partially capped by lower quotations in Oceania and the United States of America.

The **FAO Sugar Price Index** averaged 103.3 points in July, down 0.2 points (0.2 percent) from June, marking the fifth consecutive monthly decline, and 16.2 points (13.5 percent) lower than its July 2024 level. Early forecasts of a likely recovery in global sugar production in 2025/26, resulting from expectations of larger outputs in India and Thailand, coupled with favourable weather conditions in key southern growing regions in Brazil, exerted downward pressure on world sugar prices in July. However, signs of a rebound in global sugar import demand limited the overall decline.

### Fighter Jets, Frigates & Drones: Türkiye Signs \$5.85B in Export Deals at IDEF



Türkiye secured more than \$5.8 billion in defense export deals during IDEF 2025 arms fair in Istanbul, President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan said. “A total of 270 signing ceremonies were held during IDEF 2025, 65% of which focused on exports,” Erdoğan said. “The total value of the contracts signed at the fair exceeded \$9 billion,” he added, putting the estimated export share at roughly \$5.85 billion.

These developments come as Türkiye’s defense exports hit a record \$7.15 billion last year, marking a roughly 30% increase from 2022.

### 45 Turkish Construction Firms Ranked Among World's Top 250

#### Turkish contractors’ total project size reaches \$20.8B last year, according to Turkish Trade Ministry



45 Turkish contractors made it to the Engineering News-Record (ENR) magazine’s Top 250 International Contractors list, according to a statement by the Turkish Trade Ministry. Turkish contractors working around the world secured their place among the top. The number of Turkish contractors in the top 250 rose from 43 to 45 this year, the Ministry said.

“Türkiye with 45 — the value of global projects the 45 Turkish contractors undertook last year reached \$20.8 billion,” the statement read. Turkish contractors’ share of the total project value of the top 250 was 4.2%, which placed the country in the ninth place. “Eight Turkish companies made it into the top 100 on the 2025 list,” according to the Turkish Trade Ministry. “The total project value of the top 250 global contractors climbed only 0.5% to \$501.2 billion due to political uncertainties, rising labor and land costs,” it noted.

“As of today, Turkish contractors undertook a total of 12,641 projects worth over \$544.9 billion in 137 countries since 1972, through bilateral contracts and trade delegations in key markets like Libya, Iraq, and Saudi Arabia, we are supporting the contracting sector, while also aiming to play an active role in the reconstruction of Ukraine and Syria,” the statement said.

Meanwhile, eight Turkish engineering firms made it to the ENR magazine’s Top 225 International Design Firms list.
